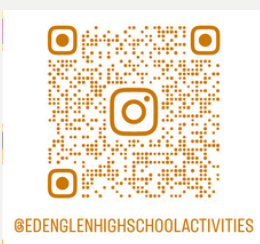

The Debating team has had a remarkable year, achieving success both locally and internationally. The team also participated in the Parktown Human Rights Tournament, reaching the Quarter finals, and engaged in several friendly debates with neighbouring schools.
